Mr. Nicholas Seymour

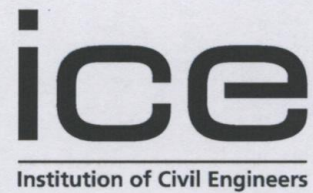
