Background:

The Chief Executive of the HKSAR announced in the 2007-2008 Policy Address that the Government will push ahead with 10 large-scale infrastructure projects. They are the Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link, Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, the Kai Tak development, the South Island Line and the Airport Rail Link etc. Besides of these, many large-scale infrastructure projects have been implemented in past 2 years i.e. Harbour Area Treatment Scheme, Drainage Improvement Scheme, Wan Chai Development Phase II, Central Reclamation Phase III, Central - Wan Chai Bypass, Reconstruction and improvement Tuen Mun Road. Our Professions have been participating and contributing their effort in these infrastructure developments.

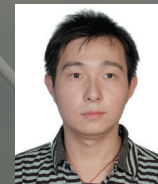

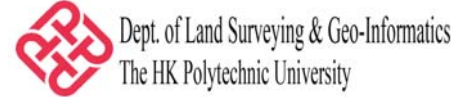
