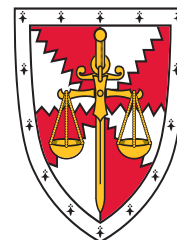




JOINT TECHNICAL VISIT

Happy Valley Underground Stormwater Storage Scheme

The Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (East Asia Branch) Young Members Group and the Chartered Institution of Civil Engineering Surveyors are jointly organising a site visit to the Happy Valley Underground Stormwater Storage Scheme (HVUSSH) project of the Drainage Services Department (DSD).

The HK\$678 million HVUSSH project is the largest NEC3 Option C Engineering and Construction Contract (ECC) awarded by the Hong Kong government to date. Designed to alleviate flood risk in the Wan Chai and Happy Valley districts, the scheme involves the construction of a 60,000m³ underground stormwater storage tank with a plan area of about 20,000m², a twin cell diversion box culvert, an automatic movable overflow side weir system, an inlet structure and a pump house. Construction of the HVUSSH commenced in 2011 and is scheduled for completion in early 2018.
