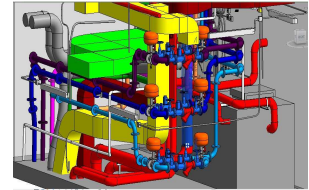

Abstract:

Building Information Modelling (BIM) in construction industry is being applied frequently. Hong Kong Construction Industry Council (HKCIC) will introduce BIM standard to construction industry next year. Great impacts will be brought to land surveying field. From preliminary stage to final stage of construction projects, much survey works can be done to assist BIM applications. In this seminar, the role and adaptation of land surveying to this changing environment will be deeply investigated.

Mr. LAM Lit Yin is the Land Surveying Manager of Champion Surveying and Engineering Co. Ltd. in Hong Kong. He would like to implement photogrammetry and laser scanning to ordinary projects in order to accelerate the pace of land and engineering surveying and enrich the surveying field. He would share experience of how to apply point cloud capturing techniques into various projects and how the technology could integrate with BIM. Mr. LAM is also the Chairman of HKIES since year 2008.

Mr. SHIN Sywan Min, who is the BIM Manager of Chun Wo Building Construction and Engineering Co. Ltd., responds to the formation and application of BIM to various projects. He had worked more than 25 years in BIM management level in different places, such as USA, Beijing, Taiwan, Macau and Hong Kong. He would like to share his opinions to the integration of land surveying and BIM.
