This seminar will provide the participants with an update on a number of latest legal developments in Hong Kong, which include the third party funding for arbitration, the new HKIAC Administered Arbitration Rules, increase of the civil jurisdictional limits of the District Court and Small Claims Tribunal and the recent signing of "The Arrangement on Reciprocal Recognition and Enforcement of Judgments in Civil and Commercial Matters between the Courts of the Mainland and Hong Kong SAR".
