The applicants has to follow the instructions and requirements of the course provider towards the COVID-19 prevention during the face to face class teaching.

This course is offered to the CICES Members (Technical Members and Full Members) at preferential tuition fees following the successful approval from the HKSAR Government for the Matching Grant For Skills Upgrading (MGSS) to the eligible applicants who commit to the successfully completion of the course with full attendance and passing the examination as required.

(4 days training is applicable to Stage 2 only, Stage 1 and 3 is to be done online by the delegates)

1. BK SURCO Certified NEC Professional Training Course

The BK SURCO Certified NEC Professional Training Course addresses the need in the Hong Kong construction industry to provide project participants with essential knowledge and understanding of the new procedures and skills required by projects using NEC ECC contracts, to assist in optimizing the delivery of these projects.

Importantly, it incorporates local practices and procedures such as the Hong Kong Government Practice Notes for Z-clauses, local procedures and ordinances and case studies in Hong Kong.

It is based upon the NEC4 ECC contract (the latest published version of the NEC ECC contract). However, differences between NEC3 ECC and NEC4 ECC will be covered in the training course.

The BK SURCO Certified NEC Professional Training Course is approved by the Chartered Institution of Civil Engineering Surveyors (CICES). The eight course modules match the essential part of the core and specialist competencies required for becoming a corporate member of ICES. Additionally, those



who successfully pass the course are eligible for inclusion in the ICES Register of Certified NEC Professionals. The course is Quality-Assured in accordance with the provisions of ISO 9001:2015.



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2. Course Structure

Stage 1

The intention of this Preparatory Course is to prepare delegates for attending the 4 days classroom training. The Preparatory Course comprises online reading material 'Summary of NEC' to familiarize course delegates with the NEC4 ECC contract. Once the pre-reading has been completed delegates are required to complete a multiple-choice assessment comprising 20 questions, to be completed within 60 minutes.

Delegates can access the Preparatory Course material immediately after payment has been confirmed. Delegates may have 3 attempts to achieve an assessment pass mark of at least 50% before the first day of the classroom training. Satisfactory completion of this stage is a pre-requisite for proceeding to Stage 2. The expected time required to complete this stage is 4 hours. Delegates who pass the assessment will receive an online certificate, which may be used for CPD purposes.

Stage 2

Delegates are required to pass Stage 1 - Preparatory Course before they can attend <u>Stage 2 -</u>

Classroom Training (4 days).

Training materials will be distributed to delegates on the first day of training:

- Presentation slides, ancillary notes, Q&A
- Copies of NEC4 Engineering Construction Contract

Stage 2 covers eight half-day modules of important aspects of NEC3 and NEC4 with case studies, interactive exercises and discussion:

- 1. Introduction, Roles and Responsibilities
- 2. Preparation and Project Setup
- 3. Collaboration and Team Integration
- 4. Contract, Subcontract and Supplier; Administration
- 5. Risk and Programme
- 6. Lump Sum and Target Cost Financial Management
- 7. Management of Change
- 8. Accounts and Project Closure

Continuous assessment marks (maximum of 20) will be assessed by the tutor based on delegates' performance (in terms of understanding, participation, and application of knowledge) during the 4 days training. Course delegates can print their online course attendance certificate following successful completion of the 4 days training.

All classroom training must be completed and the course assessment passed before delegates can take



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part in Stage 3.

Stage 3

This is a report/essay format where those who have successfully completed Stages 1 and 2 are required to submit answers online. Four questions are shown in the delegates' online training pages following acknowledgement of successful completion of Stage 2.

Course delegates can download the questions (in Word format) and provide their answers in the same file. The answers should be no more than 1,500 words per question (excluding the questions). Expected time spent in answering each question is 2 hours.

Word files containing the completed answers are then uploaded and submitted online in either Word or pdf format by clicking the button "Submit My Answer". Once delegates have submitted their answers, no subsequent amendments or addenda can be made.

BK SURCO reserves the right to take measures to check that no plagiarism has taken place in the answers submitted by delegates. Any instances of plagiarism of other delegate's answers will result in a failure of Stage 3 of the course.

Full marks for the 4 questions in Stage 3 are 80 marks (20 per question) and delegates should submit their answers within 30 days after the last day of classroom training.

The total marks scored in Stage 3 will be combined with that scored in Stage 2 and hence the full marks for this stage are 100 marks. Pass mark is 60%.

Stage 2/3 assessment results will be notified to candidates by email within 60 days of the last day of classroom training or, where an extension of the time for submission of the Stage 3 assessment has been given, then within 30 days of receipt by BK SURCO of the submission.

For successful course delegates, certificates will be issued by BK SURCO, posted out within 30 days of the Stage 2/3 notification and will be valid for 5 years from the date of issue.

All delegates who receive the certificates are eligible for inclusion in the CICES List of Certified NEC Professionals. Delegates may apply for this by following the instructions in the covering letter sent to them with the Certificate. The CICES will have charges to the delegates and please make enquiry to CICES UK Headquarters for the current registration fee.
